Pie Bake-Off at 1:00 in the Courtyard.

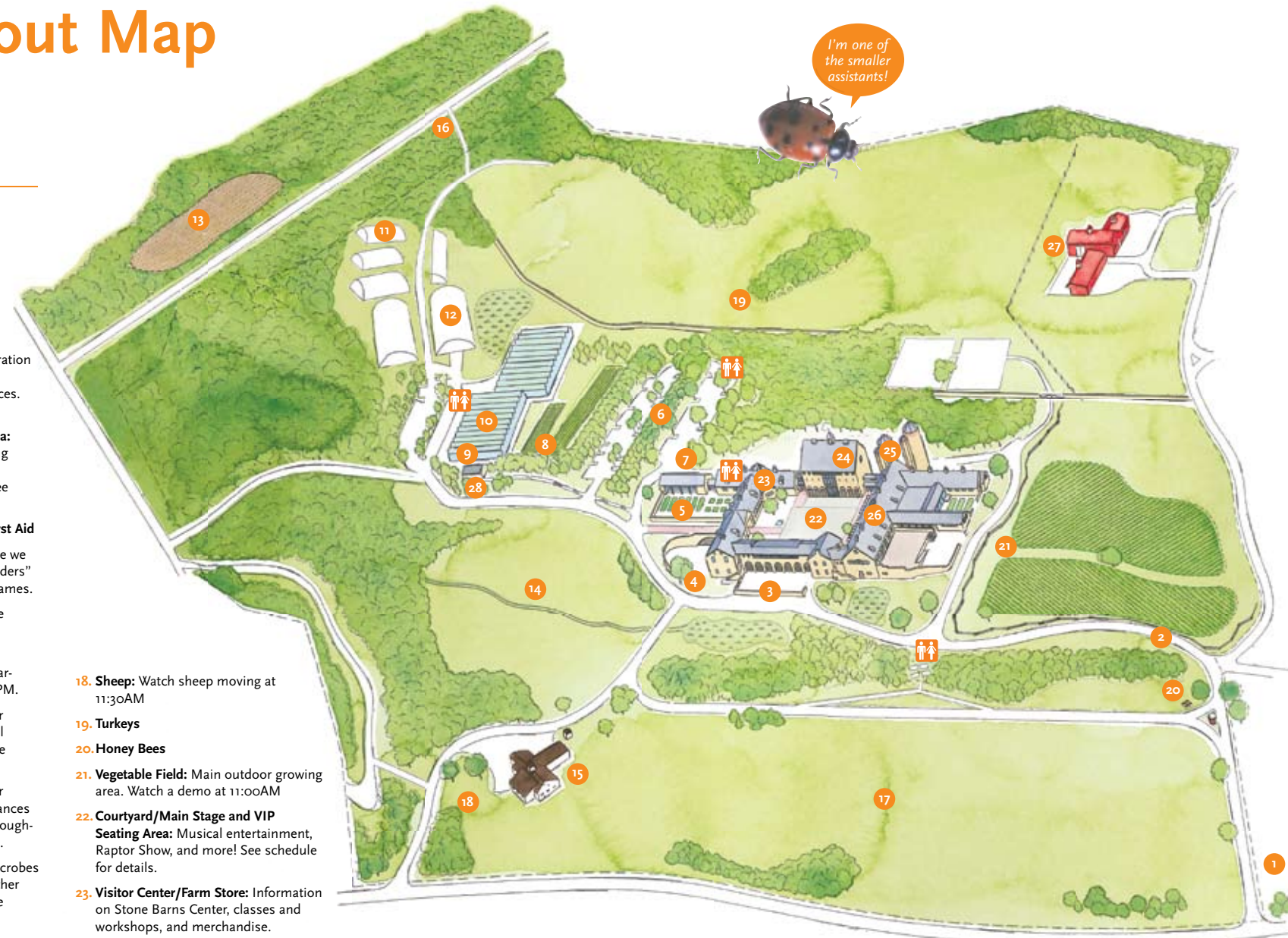


Walkabout Map

1. **Parking & Main Entrance**
2. **Welcome and check-in**
3. **Pig Roasting:** Stop by to see us roasting a heritage pig for delicious sandwiches (on sale in the Farm Market).
4. **Volunteer Check-in**
5. **Dooryard Garden:** A demonstration garden of Stone Barns Center growing techniques and practices. Also the Pie Bake-Off Drop-off.
6. **Farmers Market and Picnic Area:** A variety of local vendors selling seasonal food & drinks, with picnicking seating available. See Market Map on reverse side.
7. **Information, Lost Child and First Aid**
8. **Terrace Gardens:** Hillside where we experiment with "season extenders" such as row covers and cold frames.
9. **Hayrides:** Leaving from outside the greenhouse
10. **Greenhouse:** A full half-acre of intensely managed veggies, year-round. Watch a demo at 12:30PM.
11. **Covered Barn A:** Workshops for adults on food and farming will be held throughout the day. See flier for details.
12. **Covered Barn B:** Workshops for children/families and performances by Story Pirates will be held throughout the day. See flier for details.
13. **Compost Windrows:** Where microbes cook our kitchen scraps and other organic matter into homemade fertilizer.

15. **Poultry Processing Facility** (Not open to the public)
16. **Pigs:** Watch feeding at 2:30PM
17. **Chickens:** Watch egg collecting at 10:30AM and 1:30PM
18. **Sheep:** Watch sheep moving at 11:30AM

21. **Vegetable Field:** Main outdoor growing area. Watch a demo at 11:00AM
22. **Courtyard/Main Stage and VIP Seating Area:** Musical entertainment, Raptor Show, and more! See schedule for details.
23. **Visitor Center/Farm Store:** Information on Stone Barns Center, classes and workshops, and merchandise.
24. **Hay Barn:** Renovated from the real thing, now our education center. (Closed during Harvest Fest)

26. **Blue Hill at Stone Barns Restaurant:** Exciting dining using local ingredients. (Closed during Harvest Fest)
