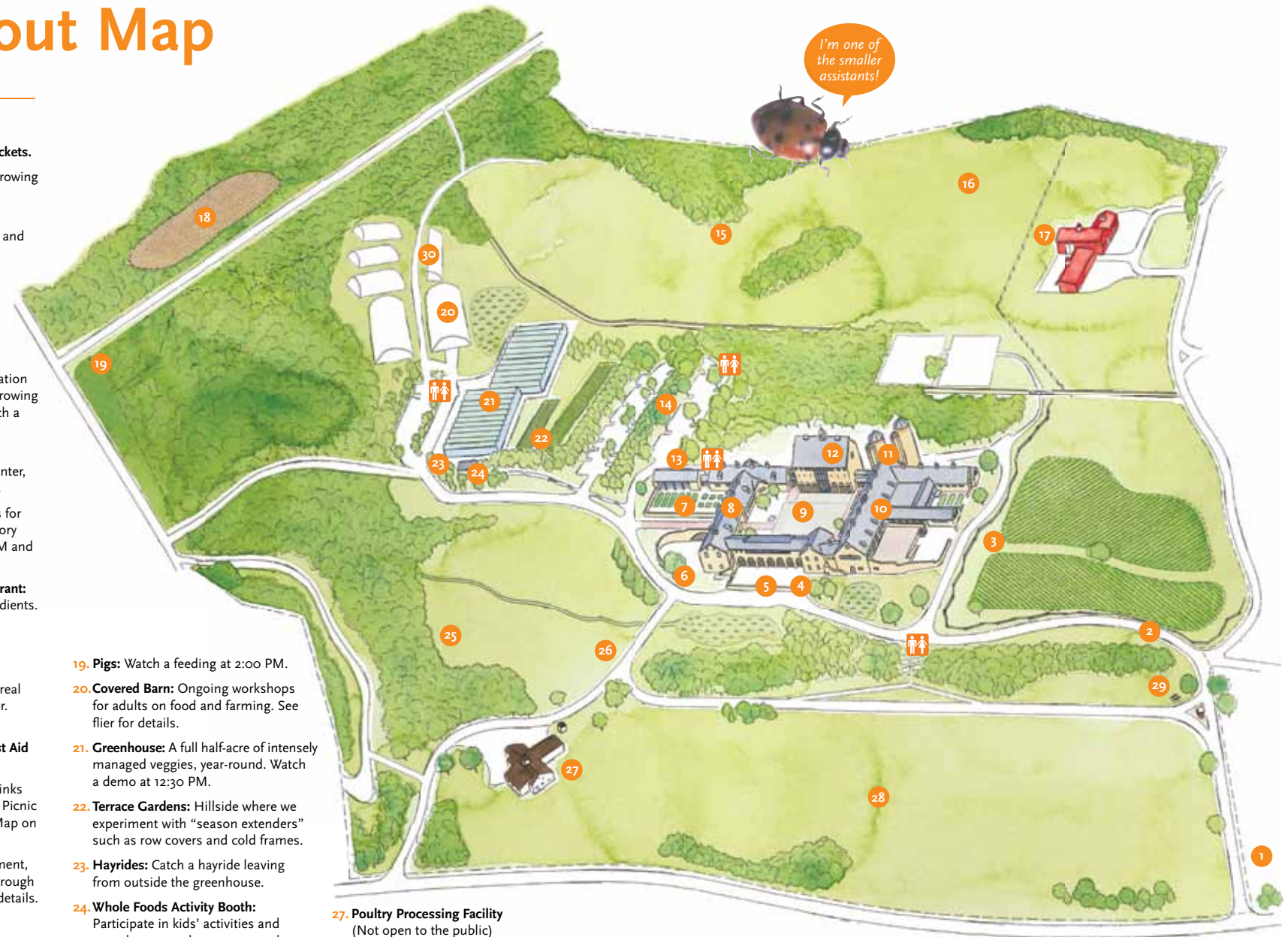


Stone Barns Raffle

1. **Parking & Main Entrance**
 2. **Welcome, check-in and raffle tickets.**
 3. **Vegetable Field:** Main outdoor growing area. Watch a demo at 11:30 AM.
 4. **Whole Foods Market Truck:** House-made pumpkin muffins and local hot apple cider
 5. **Pig Roasting:** Stop by to see us roasting a Stone Barns pig for delicious sandwiches (for sale at the Farm Market).
 6. **Volunteer Check-in**
 7. **Dooryard Garden:** A demonstration garden of Stone Barns Center growing techniques and practices. Watch a demo at 1:00 PM.
 8. **Visitor Center/Farm Store:** Information on Stone Barns Center, merchandise, and raffle tickets.
 9. **Courtyard:** Ongoing workshops for children and families. Catch Story Pirate Performances at 11:00 AM and 2:00 PM. See flier for details.
 10. **Blue Hill at Stone Barns Restaurant:** exciting dining using local ingredients. (Closed during Harvest Fest)
 11. **Silo Lobby** (Closed during Harvest Fest)
 12. **Hay Barn:** Renovated from the real thing, now our education center. (Closed during Harvest Fest)
 13. **Lost Child Information and First Aid**
 14. **Farm Market and Picnic Area:** Purchase seasonal food and drinks from a variety of local vendors. Picnic seating available. See Market Map on reverse side.
 15. **Main Stage:** Musical entertainment, raffle announcements. Enter through farm market. See schedule for details.
 16. **Sheep:** Watch sheep moving at 12:00 PM.
 17. **Our neighbor, Hudson Pines Farm's Calving Barn** (Not open to the public)
 18. **Compost Windrows:** Where microbes cook our kitchen scraps and other organic matter into homemade fertilizer. Watch a demo at 2:30 PM.
 19. **Pigs:** Watch a feeding at 2:00 PM.
 20. **Covered Barn:** Ongoing workshops for adults on food and farming. See flier for details.
 21. **Greenhouse:** A full half-acre of intensely managed veggies, year-round. Watch a demo at 12:30 PM.
 22. **Terrace Gardens:** Hillside where we experiment with "season extenders" such as row covers and cold frames.
 23. **Hayrides:** Catch a hayride leaving from outside the greenhouse.
 24. **Whole Foods Activity Booth:** Participate in kids' activities and munch on complementary snacks while waiting for the next Hayride.
 25. **Turkeys**
 26. **Farm Olympics in the Bowl Pasture:** Participate in egg-carries, farmer relays, and more!
 27. **Poultry Processing Facility** (Not open to the public)
 28. **Chickens:** Watch egg collecting at 10:30 AM and 1:30 PM.
