# Vacation Camp on the Farm

Vacation Camp is designed to bring students in 1st through 5th grade to Stone Barns Center during school vacation weeks. Each session includes garden work, animal chores, farm crafts, games and nature hikes. Students will explore the farm-to-table connection as they harvest and prepare healthy and delicious seasonal snacks with our educators. Vacation Camps foster a love for the natural world and teach campers to appreciate their local farm.

Our program is designed as a four-day farm experience, and campers enroll in the full session to ensure a rich learning experience. Registration is processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the sessions are full, a wait list will be started. Space is limited; please register early.

All campers enjoy a full day of activities on the Farm from 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM. Groups are limited to 10 campers in each age group to foster friendships and an intimate, hands-on educational experience.

Campers must bring lunch, a snack, and a water bottle to camp daily. Campers should dress for the weather and plan to be outdoors for most of the day.



## Winter Camp: February 21 – 24th

**Farm Explorers, Grades 1 – 2**  
**Farmers-in-Training, Grades 3 – 5**

Stone Barns Center is a four-season farm. Winter Campers learn how to care for plants and animals during the colder months. Farm chores may include egg collecting, harvesting in the greenhouse, and tapping maple trees. Campers also explore the Rockefeller State Park, make seasonal crafts, and create farm-fresh snacks.

## Spring Camp: April 2 – 5th

**Farm Explorers, Grades 1 – 2**  
**Farmers-in-Training, Grades 3 – 5**

Spring Campers will meet new lambs and piglets, and help our gardeners prepare planting beds for the upcoming season. Farm chores may include feeding pigs and sheep and transplanting seedlings from the propagation room into the field. Campers will also make seasonal crafts, create healthy snacks, and explore the wooded areas around the farm as they come alive in the spring.

### Refund Policy

Withdrawal at least 2 weeks in advance of the start date: Total fee less 25% for administrative costs will be refunded. Withdrawal within 2 weeks of the start date: No refunds will be issued. In case of closure due to inclement weather, Farm Camp will refund payment for missed dates.

### Medical Policy

Camp Educators and Farm Staff are trained in CPR & First Aid, however there is no registered nurse on site. By law, Stone Barns Farm Camp Staff are not permitted to administer medication to your camper. Your child must self-administer any medication that you bring. If you are sending your child to camp with medication, you must provide a signed doctor's note outlining dosage and schedule. Medication must be sealed and clearly labeled with your child's name. All medication must have a current manufacturer's expiration date. If you have any questions about our medical policy, please contact Meghan directly.
